



Golden deer goblet



The most important thing is the glass goblet, which can be used as a vase or for candles, or even for beer especially, where I live in Bavaria.



Materials:

- glass goblet
- rice paper
- napkin with deers on it
- varnish (water based)
- napkin glue
- stencil
- goldfoil glue
- goldfoil
- silver pigment powder
- alcohol spray
- solvent varnish (spray)



Method:

- rip the rice paper in small pieces
- fix it on the goblet with the varnish
- it would air-dry in 12 hours, but you can also blow dry it
- rip the napkin around your motive and fix it with napkin glue
- after it's dry, go on with stencil and gold foil glue
- When the glue isn't white anymore you can put on the foil



We could basically stop right here, just put on varnish in two layers.
But if you would like something special:

- use silver pigment powder, alcohol and compressed air spray
- put on the pigment powder slowly, fix it with alcohol spray and form it with the compressed air spray

You get different forms when you let it dry a few hours and put on two layers of solvent varnish. If you want a glow, sand it carefully and put on three more layers of the solvent varnish.

You can also send it with a robe for a few hours.

Tipps:

- remove oil before you start
- remove dust
- be patient while your work is drying
